Our next meal prep for F.O.O.D. is Friday, July 12th, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at Saint John XXIII Church (35 Colby Drive, Cole Harbour). For this meal prep, we prepare Goulash Casserole, Ham/Turkey/Chicken/Bologna Sandwiches, Coleslaw, veggie bags & muffins.

If you would like to donate to the meal prep, the ingredients are:

Macaroni pasta (900 grams), tomato sauce, diced tomatoes (796ml), ground beef (we use 20lbs), onions, block & sliced cheese, loaf of bread (we make 80+ sandwiches), deli meat (ham, turkey, chicken, or bologna), cabbage (green or red), carrots, chocolate chips, cherry tomatoes, baby carrots, granola bars, fruit or pudding cups.

These items can be left at the parish office or at any of the churches. Financial donations are always welcome to help purchase supplies. Supplies and sign-up sheets are at each church or join us at Saint John XXIII church hall and we will find some work for you to do.
